


2013 City of Columbus Public Safety Citizens Academy



The Citizen's Academy is a free service of the Columbus Police Department designed to educate citizens about public safety operations. Participants will meet each Thursday evening from 6:00 p.m. - 9:00 p.m. for 10 weeks, Aug. 22th - October 24th. Presentations will be provided by the Columbus Police Department, Bartholomew County Sheriff's Department, Columbus Fire Department, and Bartholomew County Emergency Operations Center on the following topics:

- 911 Response
- Use of Force
- Fire Response and Technical Rescue
- Patrol Tactics
- Criminal Investigations
- K-9
- Crime Scene Investigation
- Training

Participants will have the opportunity to "ride-along" with a police officer while on patrol. Additionally, tours of the Bartholomew County Jail, Emergency Operations Center, and Columbus Police Department will be conducted. You must be 18 years of age to participate and pass a criminal record check. The Citizen's Academy is free of charge.
