## What division will my child be in?

The aging date that we will use is 7/31/2015. Your child's age on that day will determine his/her division.

Example: If your child's birthday is 8/15/2005, he/she will play in the U10 (under 10) age group. Although they are 10 when the league starts in the spring, they were not 10 on the cut-off date.

**All children must be 4 by 1/31/2016!**

(This year 12U & 14U have been combined into 14U)

## Referee Orientation

# Frequently Asked Questions

## **When are the game played?**

Games are played on Saturday mornings at 8:30, 10 and 11:30 am at Blackwell Park behind Parkside School.

## **When will I hear from my child's coach?**

The coaches will receive their rosters on March 1st. You should receive a call / email from your child's coach by March 11th. If you do not hear from them by this time, call Donner Center at (812) 376- 2680.

## **How long is the season?**

There are six games beginning on April 2nd and ending May 7th.

## **What about practices?**

Teams will be scheduled for 1-2 practices a week. The coach will determine the day / time and contact you with the information.

## **Can my child change teams if he/she has a schedule conflict?**

Unfortunately, no. Due to the size of our soccer program we cannot accommodate everyone. We instead require coaches not to cut a child's playing time simply because they are unable to attend practice.

## **Does Parks provide uniforms?**

Parks and Rec will give each player a uniform t-shirt. All player must provide their own shin guards and long socks (**required**). Cleats are optional and are the player's responsibility.

## **Is there anything my child cannot wear?**

Yes!!! Players cannot have beads or hard objects in their hair as well as no jewelry (earrings included). New piercings **cannot** be covered with tape.

## **What if I have a problem?**

Go to your coach first. If that does not help, please contact the division manager for your child's age group.
