Station 1: Results of Past Voting on Transportation Scenarios

Station 2: Prioritize Transportation Goals

We want to know which one of the transportation goals developed for Columbus and Bartholomew County is most important to you! Take a few minutes to read the six goals on the boards displayed on easels, and vote by placing a sticker in the box corresponding to your choice.

Station 3: Prioritize Transportation Projects

Through previous public open houses, steering committee meetings, and staff input, eight projects have been designated Priority A, and are shown on the Priority A map. Please let us know which of these projects is most important to you by voting with your transportation bucks. You can use your bucks to vote for three different projects, or spend them all on one.

Priority B & C projects, as well as “Alternatively Funded” projects are shown on other maps. If you want to use your transportation bucks for any of these projects, write the project category and number on the back of a transportation buck and place it in the “Other” Box (for example, “C1”).
