General Summary: General wastewater treatment plant operations along with some maintenance duties.

Specific Duties: Perform routine sampling of flows and treatment process. Perform control tests, calculations, interpret data. Perform laboratory tests related to the process control data. Check equipment, record flows, pressure and levels of process tankage. Computer data entry, monitor and record weather conditions. Perform other duties as needed.

Education and/or Qualifications: High School diploma or equivalent required. Desired applicants should have experience in the operation of wastewater treatment plants. Applicants with an equivalent combination of education, training, and relevant work experience, which provides the requisite knowledge, skills, and abilities for this position are preferred.

Licenses or Certifications: Must have a valid Indiana Driver's License and maintain it at all times. Must have a good driving record, sufficient to be covered by city insurance as a driver while on duty.

Supervisory Responsibility: None

Relationships Responsibility: Will be required to work in other departments as needed.

Working Conditions: Will be required to work in inclement weather.

Remarks: Must reside in Bartholomew County or an adjoining county within six (6) months of employment.
