Service Animals

Owners must have control of service animal at all times. Animals that are not Guide, Signal, or Service Animals are considered pets and must be carried in an appropriate enclosed carrier (pet taxi).

Rules



Drinks with screw on lids are allowed. All others are prohibited. Eating is not allowed on the bus.



Carts, walkers, and strollers must be folded (unless small enough to fit on your lap, between your feet, without taking up other seats) and secured out of the aisle. Drivers are not permitted to assist.



Elementary aged children (and under) must be accompanied by someone at least 14 years old.



Pets in carriers are permitted if they fit on your lap.



Smoking/vaping is not allowed on the bus or at bus stops.



For safety reasons, avoid talking to the driver while bus is in motion.



Laundry must be in sealed containers only and limited to what you can carry in one trip.



Personal items must fit under the seat or in your lap and limited to what you can carry in one trip.



Shoes and a shirt must be worn while on the bus. No wet bathing suits. T-shirts must be worn over bathing suits.



Use headphones with all electronic devices. No speaker chat.



No sleeping



Profanity and unruly behavior is not tolerated.



Priority seating area is for seniors and persons with disabilities.



No carrying firearms or weapons of any type. (Unless specifically authorized by law)

How To Ride

Be visible at the bus stop.

- Wave to the driver.
- Wear light colored clothing.
- Use flashlight or cell phone light at night or early morning.
- Make sure we don't pass you by!

Take a Seat

- Hand to handrail while boarding.
- Hold on. Use handrails to steady yourself on the way to your seat.
- Choose your seat quickly and sit down, then avoid changing seats while the bus is in motion.
- Standing is permissible if holding onto a handrail.
- Do not block the aisle.
- Watch for your stop and pull yellow cord one block prior to stop.
- Driver will drop you off at designated stop.
- All riders must be behind yellow safety line while bus is in motion.

Exiting

- Exit from rear door whenever possible.
- NEVER cross in front of bus.
- Wait until the bus drives away so you have a clear view of traffic.

Mobility Devices

- All mobility devices will be secured with a four point securement system.
- All motorized mobility devices should be turned off after boarding and remain turned off until driver has completed restraint removal.
- No items can be hanging on the back or side of mobility device.
- If the pick up or drop off site is unsafe, the passenger may be asked to board or disembark at an alternate safe location.
- Transfer to a seat if possible.

Courtesy

- No feet on the seats
- No skates worn on the bus
- No hazardous materials, including weapons of any kind, explosives, corrosive liquids, gas cans (unless new and empty) and flammable materials.
- No bags of aluminum cans
- No pan-handling
- No soliciting
- No joy riding
- Ride quietly and respect the rights of other passengers
- No littering or unsanitary conditions in buses or at stops

ColumBUS Rack & Roll

- Racks are designed to accomodate two wheeled single seat bicycles.
- Please make sure all loose personal items are removed from bike.
- Wait until the bus has come to a complete stop and bus has been lowered prior to stepping toward bus to load bike.
- Make eye contact with the bus driver to ensure it is safe to approach the bus.
- If you are a first time Rack & Roll user, the driver may instruct you on how to properly and safely secure your bike if needed.

- Pull down the bike rack mounted on the front of the bus by squeezing the handle and lowering the rack
- Load your bike, using the slots closest to the bus first. Make sure that the handlebars face the curbside of the bus. For the second bike, the handlebars should face the street side of the bus.
- To secure your bike in the rack, raise the support arm to the top of the FRONT TIRE. After the bicycle
 is secured, go ahead and board the bus.
- There is no extra fee for using our Rack & Roll service. Children 12 and under may use the rack only when accompanied by an adult.
- Bicycles are not permitted on the bus.

- Unload your bike and stay near the curbside of the bus, never the traffic side.
- If no one is waiting to load a bike or there are no other bikes in the rack, fold the rack up toward the bus and it will lock in place automatically.
- Be aware of vehicle traffic when loading or unloading your bicycle.
- Be sure to load and unload your bicycle towards the curb.
- Avoid kneeling or squatting out of the bus drivers line of vision. When loading or unloading bike, make eye contact with the driver.
- ColumBUS is not responsible for damage incurred to bicycles on ColumBUS bicycle racks.
