**A RESOLUTION BY THE COLUMBUS AREA METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION (CAMPO)
POLICY BOARD FOR THE PURPOSE OF**

AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2024-2028 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP)

WHEREAS, the Columbus Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (CAMPO) is the designated Metropolitan Planning Organization responsible for transportation planning in the City of Columbus and Bartholomew County; and

WHEREAS, the development of a Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), which includes local and state projects requesting federal funding, is a requirement of the U.S. Department of Transportation and part of the comprehensive planning process; and

WHEREAS, funding for a local project has shifted from including a federal match to being all locally funded, resulting in deletion from the TIP, and said CAMPO funding will be allocated accordingly through future TIP approvals; and

WHEREAS, the TIP is developed by CAMPO staff for the Policy Board, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the CAMPO Policy Board that the amendments to the FY 2024-2028 TIP are hereby approved the 12th day of May, 2025.
