
**WHEREAS**, the Columbus Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (CAMPO) is the designated Metropolitan Planning Organization responsible for transportation planning in the City of Columbus and Bartholomew County; and

**WHEREAS**, the development of a Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), which includes local and state projects requesting federal funding, is a requirement of the U.S. Department of Transportation and part of the comprehension planning process; and


**WHEREAS**, INDOT has specific maintenance and improvement projects on their state-owned facilities which are in the CAMPO planning area (Bartholomew County) and thus must be in the TIP if federal funds are to be expended on these projects; and

**WHEREAS**, the TIP is developed by CAMPO staff for the Policy Board; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the CAMPO Policy Board that the amendments to the FY 2026-2030 TIP are hereby approved the 11<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2026.
