RESOLUTION OF THE COLUMBUS REDEVELOPMENT COMMISSION TO ENGAGE THE SERVICES OF

AUGUST MACK ENVIRONMENTAL

Comes now the Columbus Department of Redevelopment, more commonly known as the Columbus Redevelopment Commission, and for this Resolution says as follows:

WHEREAS, Indiana Code §36-7-14-1 *et seq.* provides that a community may establish a Department of Redevelopment to be controlled by a Redevelopment Commission; and

WHEREAS, the City of Columbus, through its Common Council, did on August 19, 2003 create the City of Columbus Department of Redevelopment and the City of Columbus Redevelopment Commission (Redevelopment Commission) by way of Ordinance Number 25, 2003; and

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Commission owns property requiring the abandonment and removal of monitoring wells associated with remediation of property through the State of Indiana's Brownfield program.

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Commission has cause to engage professional services for the abandonment and removal of approximately 38 monitoring wells as it has been determined by the Brownfield Program that no further monitoring is required.

WHEREAS, August Mack Environmental has the experience, skills, and resources to complete these services.

WHEREAS, the Director of Redevelopment is recommending that the Commission engage August Mack Environmental to design tasks to accomplish these outcomes.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED:

- 1. The City of Columbus Redevelopment Commission having heard from its Director, now finds and concludes that it would benefit the Commission and this project to engage the services of August Mack Environmental to utilize their experience, skill and resources to provide the desired services.
- 2. This would be a beneficial service and August Mack Environmental should be employed to provide the same to this Commission.
- 3. This contract shall not exceed the amount of \$12,700.00.

- 4. The City of Columbus Redevelopment Commission does herby agree to engage August Mack Environmental to perform these services.
- 5. The President of the Commission, or his designee, is authorized to execute said contract for and on behalf of the Commission.
