

ORDINANCE NO. 34, 2022

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, INDIANA,
FIXING THE SALARIES OF ELECTED OFFICIALS
FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2023

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Columbus, Indiana, desires to set forth the salaries of certain elected officials for the year 2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION I

The salary of the Mayor of the City of Columbus shall be set at one-hundred eight thousand three-hundred and forty-seven dollars (\$108,347.00) for the year 2023.

SECTION II

The salary of the Clerk Treasurer of the City of Columbus shall be set at eighty-nine thousand eight-hundred and forty-eight dollars (\$89,848.00) for the year 2023.

SECTION III

The salary of each of the seven (7) Council Members of the Columbus Common Council shall be set at fifteen-thousand nine-hundred and eighty-four dollars (\$15,984.00) for the year 2023.


SECTION IV

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage. Taxpayers appearing at such meetings shall have a right to be heard thereon.

SECTION V

In addition to the above salaries, the Mayor and the Clerk Treasurer, as full-time city employees, shall also be entitled to the same fringe benefits as other full-time city employees as set forth within the City of Columbus Personnel Policy Manual.
