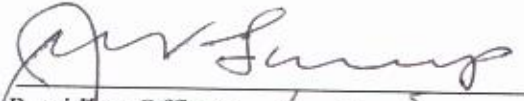
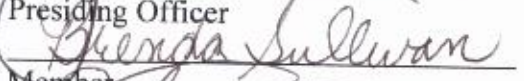
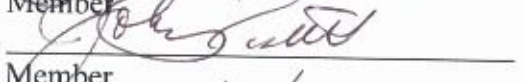

Bryan Burton, Director of Department of Public Works, requested the Board's approval to **mow the following properties:**

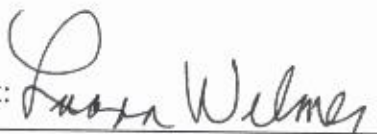
