II. Old Business Requiring Council Action

A. Reading of a Resolution entitled, "RESOLUTION NO. 3, 2023, A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A FISCAL PLAN FOR PROPERTY TO BE ANNEXED TO THE CITY OF COLUMBUS." (TMC Developers Annexation) Jeff Bergman, Planning Director, presented this resolution and the following two ordinances (Items B and C) at the same time. He explained the applicant, TMC Developers, LLC, is proposing to annex property to the City of Columbus and rezone that property from AP (Agriculture: Preferred) to I3c (Industrial: Heavy with Commitments) for future industrial development. Jeff stated the property is located on the north side of 450 South / State Road 58, generally between county roads 300 and 400 West. He reported the area for annexation and rezoning is approximately 153 acres. Jeff stated all city departments indicated they could provide their services to the property in the same manner as the rest of the city. He displayed maps and photographs of the area. Jeff stated the Columbus Plan Commission forwarded the rezoning request to City Council with a favorable recommendation of a six (6) in favor and two (2) opposed. Much discussion followed.
