The Board of Public Works & Safety met in regular session on Tuesday, October 10, 2023, at 11:00 a.m.

Robin Hilber, Assistant Director of Community Development, requested the Board's approval of a **Temporary License Agreement with Cummins, Inc. to put up holiday decorations in 2023 on Cummins property**. 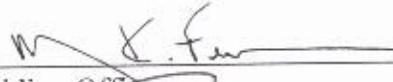
Andrew Beckort requested the Board's approval to **open bids for #23-05 2023 Pedestrian Signal Improvements**. Two bids were received:

All Star Paving	\$630,417.84

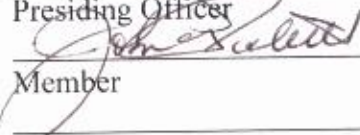
Andrew requested the bids be taken under advisement. John Picket made a motion to approve the request. Brenda Sullivan seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

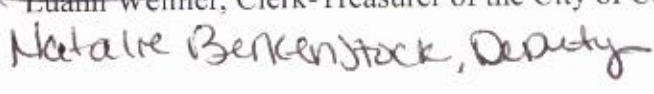
