City Council President Frank Miller appeared in person and called a regular meeting of the City Common Council to order at approximately 6:00 p.m. in Council Chambers.

I. Meeting Called to Order

- A. Councilor Jay Foyst introduced Dr. Brent Parker with Christ Fellowship Church who provided the invocation.
- B. Councilor Jay Foyst led the Pledge of Allegiance.
- C. Roll Call was taken: Chris Bartels, Elaine Hilber, Jerone Wood, Kent Anderson, Frank Miller, Jay Foyst, Josh Burnett, Tom Dell, and Grace Kestler were present in person.
- D. Councilor Hilber made a motion to approve the minutes from the Common Council meeting on May 19, 2026, as presented. Councilor Foyst seconded the motion. Motion passed by a vote of nine (9) in favor and zero (0) opposed.

III. New Business

- A. Reading of a Resolution entitled "RESOLUTION NO. 3, 2026, A RESOLUTION APPROVING A DEDUCTION FOR PROPERTY TAX ABATEMENT IN A PREVIOUSLY DESIGNATED ECONOMIC REVITALIZATION AREA PURSUANT TO INDIANA CODE 6-1.1-12.1, ET. SEQ. AND AUTHORIZING THE PRESIDENT OF THE COMMON COUNCIL TO EXECUTE THE STATEMENT OF BENEFITS FORMS" (Capco LLC Tax Abatement) Paul Smith, Assistant Director of Community Development, presented this Resolution. He introduced Dan Arnholt, President of Capco LLC, and Jun Hashizume, Vice President of Capco LLC. Paul explained Capco is requesting a real property tax abatement and a personal property tax abatement at their current facility located at 1349 Arcadia Drive. He stated Capco is making an investment of \$1,182,070 in new manufacturing equipment and an investment of \$375,272 to expand their current facility. As a result of these investments, four new positions will be added, and 108 current positions will be retained. Jun Hashizume explained that Capco manufactures safety components, with Toyota being one of their customers. Councilor Dell reported the Incentive Review Committee met prior to the Council meeting and found the application from Capco LLC to be in substantial compliance. President Miller opened the meeting for public comment. Phil Wagner, President of Greater Columbus Economic Development Corporation, stated on behalf of their board and organization they are in support of Capco and their investment in the community. President Miller closed the meeting for public comment. Discussion followed. Councilor Dell made a motion to pass the Resolution as presented. Councilor Anderson seconded the motion. Roll call vote as follows:

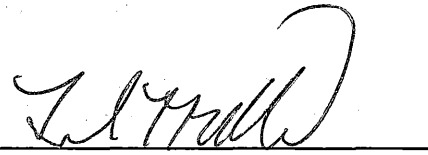

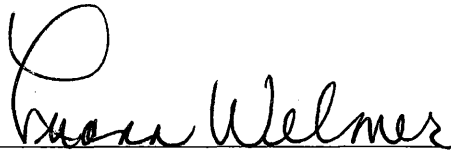
Motion passed by a vote of nine (9) in favor and zero (0) opposed.
